HOMEWORK/ PROJECTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Complete work • Meet deadlines • Work independently as far as possible • Pride in work. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Check on work/sign diary • Encourage, assist (where necessary) • Provide learner with necessary resources/materials • Encourage independent working, do NOT DO work for learner. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Give due dates ahead of time • Explain what is expected • Check if on track with projects at various intervals • Correct / mark • Give feedback.
CLASS WORK	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Come prepared: books, stationery, equipment, positive attitude, self-discipline. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ensure that learner has packed correct books in case the night before • Provide learner with the necessary stationery and equipment 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Be prepared • Check that learners have necessary resources • Check/mark books.
TESTS / EXAMINATIONS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Books up-to-date • Study timetable • Thorough preparation (i.e. time for revision) • STUDY! 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Show interest, encourage & motivate • Provide a quiet learning environment • Ask for results - discuss • Collect reports and discuss with learner. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Give dates / timetable ahead of time • Explain what is expected / what work will be covered / breakdown of marks • Mark • Give feedback (learner / parent) • Intervention / Reward
